1. TDA and Resorts World Rules apply in all PokerAtlas Tour events
2. Buy-in is \$250 (Prize Pool) + \$50 (\$30/\$20 Admin/Staff).
3. Single re-entry available through the close of registration (start of level 9) for \$300
4. Players are required to have a Genting Rewards card in order to play
5. Games will rotate after 8 hands have been played. The game and the button will be randomly drawn prior to the start of the tournament.



GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The \$300 Omaha 8/Stud 8 event (the "Tournament") is a one day event.
2. All tournament participants must be a Genting Rewards member with a card or an active cardless card.
3. The Tournament entry fee is \$300 (the "Entry fee"), \$30 of which withheld for the Tournament fee and \$20 of which withheld for poker staff. \$250 of each entry will fund the Tournament prize pool.
4. The Tournament entry fee and all re-entries must be paid with cash or Resorts World casino chips; no other forms of payment will be accepted.
5. Registration and Single re-entry will be available until the start of level 9.
6. Players start with 25,000 in tournament chips.
placed on the alternate list until they check in with the tournament staff.
7. At the conclusion of the registration period, all paid entries (including alternates) who have yet to be seated will be assigned a seat and their tournament chips will be put into play even if they are not present.
8. All alternates (present or not) will have their tournament chips put in play in numerical order when the tournament has alternates on standby.
9. The first 6 levels will play 20 minutes per level, 30 minute levels after registration is closed. Breaks will be at scheduled intervals.
10. Tables will be played 8 handed, unless mandated otherwise, the final table will be played 9 handed.
11. IRS Compliance requires a valid government issued ID and a social security number. Nonresident aliens are subject to 30% US Tax withholding. ITIN's are required for Treaty Country exemptions. All players winning \$5,000 or greater (net of Tournament Entry Fee) will be issued a W-2G tax form.
12. Resorts World Poker and standard TDA rules apply.
13. Players and guests must be at least 21 years of age.
14. Players and guests will be required to adhere to all applicable Resorts World Las Vegas policies.
15. Resorts World Las Vegas reserves the right to refuse entry to, or disqualify, any individual at any time before, during, or after the Tournament, for any reason in Resorts World Las Vegas' sole discretion.
16. Players who are unable to participate or have been disqualified, are not entitled to any refunds or payouts.
